SUPPLY LIST

PAINT: Earth tones such as yellow ochre, raw and burnt sienna, and others are recommended. In the blue tones, Paynes grey, cobalt and ultramarine are nice to include. A few yellows such as Naples, lemon and cadmium and any others are fine. Basic reds such as cadmium, alizarin, and others will work. Greens can simply be mixed if needed.

BRUSHES: A flat brush and a few rounds in various ranges as well as a liner

PAPER: Bring a paper you are comfortable with. I prefer Arches cold press in the 140-to-300-pound range or watercolor board.

BASICS: Paper towels, 1-2 water containers, pencils, kneaded erasers, spritzers, etc.

OTHER: Masking fluid such as Pebeo Drawing gum or other easy to remove masking fluid and Dr. Ph. Martin's Bleed Proof White.
